

## RESOLUTION

Whereas, the continued, indiscriminate destruction of survey monuments during construction activities is deemed a serious disservice to the public; and,

Whereas, the cost, impact and effort to prevent destruction of survey monuments is significantly less than the cost, impact and effort to reestablish them, and,

Whereas, Professional Land Surveyors are licensed by the State of Wyoming for the purpose of protecting the private property rights of the citizens of the State; and,

Whereas, the Professional Land Surveyors of Wyoming is organized to encourage and promote better land surveying practices;

Now, therefore, let it be resolved, that the Professional Lands Surveyors of Wyoming will take an active effort to prevent the destruction of survey monuments by:

1. Educating the public about identifying survey monuments and the importance of preventing their destruction;
2. Promoting state legislation that will require the identification and preservation of survey monuments during construction activities;
3. Promoting town/city ordinances and county regulations that will require the identification and preservation of survey monuments during construction activities;
4. Working with other state-licensed professionals and their professional societies to promote the identification and preservation of survey monuments in their construction projects.
