Application Process and Deadlines

Applications for scholarships are reviewed by the scholarship committee which makes a recommendation to the PLSW Board of Directors. Include a letter of recommendation from a practicing, professional land surveyor who is an active member of Professional Land Surveyors of Wyoming and which includes a reference to being familiar with your plans to become a professional land surveyor.
