INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS APPLICABLE TO THE APPLICATION FOR A PLSW SCHOLARSHIP

Application Process and Deadlines

Applications for scholarships are reviewed by the scholarship committee which makes a recommendation to the PLSW Board of Directors. Scholarships are awarded by the Board at the regular PLSW Board of Directors meetings which are held in May, August and November. Applications must be received by the following dates: July 1 for Fall Semester; Oct 1 for Spring Semester; April 1 for Summer Semester. Scholarships will be awarded for no more than two consecutive semesters. A new application must be submitted for additional scholarships.

Letter of Recommendation

Include a letter of recommendation from a practicing, professional land surveyor who is an active member of Professional Land Surveyors of Wyoming and which includes a reference to being familiar with your plans to become a professional land surveyor.

Career Plans

On a separate sheet, please describe your Career Plans including your proposed degree program, its relationship to land surveying and include an answer to this question: Do you plan to practice the profession of land surveying in Wyoming?

Financial Status

On a separate sheet, please describe your financial resources and needs. Include efforts you are making to earn the necessary funds and parental assistance.
